Regardless of the country of origin or citizenship status, if an applicant's native language is not English, they must demonstrate proficiency in the English language before they will be considered for admission to any credit course or credit program. This includes online courses and part-time study.

NWP reserves the right to use discretion in determining language proficiency. Fulfillment of one of the listed requirements does not guarantee admission. Meeting ELP requirements for admission to NWP does not guarantee that a student meets the ELP requirements of other post-secondary institutions. Students are responsible for ensuring that they meet the ELP requirements for the institutions to which they intend to transfer. Applicants can satisfy ELP admission requirements in one of the following ways for most programs:

Achieve an acceptable score on an approved ELP test – Test results are considered valid for two years from the date the

Enrollment must be in a regular high school or postsecondary for-credit program. Where students are registered in both ESL and regular programs, the ESL hours will be deducted from the total educational hours. Proof of three years of education must be submitted in the form of official transcripts, including details on course enrollment and hours of instruction. Failing grades/courses will not be counted when calculating full-time attendance. Only courses with passing grades will be considered.
