Course Content:	The subject matter will include organic and geometric objects, portraiture, landscape and exterior spaces. There may be the introduction of the human figure.		
Evaluation:	There will be two portfolio submissions. The first portfolio will be due at midterm, the second at the end of term. At the end of term, you will be required to submit all of the work done since the beginning of term. Each portfolio submission is worth 50% of your final grade. AT the end of the course, the work from both portions will be review together and a final grade will reflect an average of the grades assessed.  Your grade will be assessed according to the following: standard of work achieved, attendance, ability to fulfill assignment objectives, openness to instruction, time spent additional to class hours, participation in discussions and critiques, timely completion of assignments, progress achieved overall, attitude towards fellow students, staff, course work and deadlines.
