The Associate of Science is a Grande Prairie Regional College credential to recognize the attainment of skills, attitudes, and behaviours critical to future success. Specifically, the credential recognizes the completion of university level studies aimed at the achievement of three integrated goals: academic skills, personal management skills, and teamwork skills. The GPRC Associate of Science credential does not guarantee admission to a university program or degree. Consequently, students pursuing a university degree will want to ensure that their course selections meet the transfer requirements to their chosen University degree programs.

To qualify for the Associate of Science credential, a student will have successfully completed sixty credits of university-level courses with a minimum GPA of 1.7. GPRC will automatically recognize and award the Associate of Science credential to all-students successfully completing the academic curriculum listed below while enrolled in university studies.

Curriculum, 60 credits*

- » 6 credits Junior English
- » 6 credits from courses offered within math, statistics, computing science
- » 6 credits from courses offered within chemistry, physics
- » 6 credits from courses offered within biological sciences, earth and atmospheric sciences, science psychology
- » 12 credits (maximum) of 1000-level science options
- » 6 credits of arts or science options
- » 18 credits (minimum) of 2000-level and above science options
- *Normally, no one course will fulfill more than one requirement.

Advanced Standing

You may transfer credits from other institutions or accumulate credits by way of advanced standing or challenge procedures. However, in order to qualify for the Associate of Science or the Diploma in University Studies, at least fifty percent of the requirements, thirty credits, must normally be completed at Grande Prairie Regional College.
