**Business Administration & Office Administration articulation agreement**

agreement between Office Administration and Business Administration.

**Discussion:** The departments of OA and BA are requesting this new agreement that

states:

Office Administration students completing both the Standard Certificate (30 credits) and one of the OA Diplomas – Computerized Accounting Assistant, Legal Secretary Specialist, or MicroComputer Specialist – (30 + 30 credits) with an overall GPA of 2.5 or better will be given advances standing in the Business Administration Diploma program for 8 courses (24 credits).

Based on completion of a 60 credit OA Diploma, the student will be deemed to have covered the material in BA1010, BA1020, BA 1110, BA1150 and 4 non-specified Business options.

In the past, advanced standing has been applied on a course-by-course basis. Depending on the courses chosen for an OA diploma, an OA grad may have been granted Advanced Standing for as few as 12 or 15 credits (4 or 5 courses) in the BA Diploma program.

Students wishing to pursue this option will be advised on an individual basis.

Nursing Education/Health Studies

**Bachelor of Science in Nursing** 

**Motion:** Recommend that Academic Council approve the change to the Math

requirements for admission into the Bachelor of Science in Nursing

Program.

**Discussion:** Alberta Education has made changes to the Math curriculum in high

schools. The Department is asking to change the admission requirements

from "...one of Mathematics 31 or Pure Mathematics 30 (or their

equivalents)".

Suggestion was made to leave the previous requirements also as this change will not affect students requesting admission until 2013. B. Hessler will take this back to the department for further discussion and clarification.

better reflects current practice.


MU2800 3(3-0-0) 45 Hours Introduction to the Study of Western Music History
