COURSE DESCRIPTION:

An introductory level studio course designed to develop basic perceptual and recording skills primarily through the use of monochromatic media. The course will cover the basic principles and techniques of drawing. Studio based course involving the use of landscape, still-life and will form a high percentage of the course. The human figure may be used during the last few classes.

The second unit will introduce the light and dark modelling of a volumetric form. (about mid Term)

Three dimensional or pictorial space Modelling of a form Further attention to arrangement of a composition Light and dark tonal development

This will be determined by the instructor. Students will be expected to invest a minimum of six hours a week out of class.
