BA 1420 - BUSINESS LAW (PEACE RIVER)

TEXT: The Law and Business Administration in Canada, 6th edition,
Smyth, Soberman & Easson.

PREREQUISITE: Nil.

COURSE DESCRIPTION: This course is intended to provide an overview of the areas of contract, tort and business law; those fields most likely to be encountered in commercial practice.

COURSE OBJECTIVES: Class discussion will focus around the questions, problems and cases found at the end of each chapter. Students are expected and required to attend each class having read the assigned chapters and prepared answers for the work, which will be assigned on a weekly basis.

Students are urged to understand the importance of keeping abreast of the workload; the concepts are difficult and the workload considerable. Memorization play little role in course materials.
