COURSE DESCRIPTION: An introduction to investments for individuals. Some of the topics to be covered include: the economic environment and how it affects investments, taxation of investments, tax shelters, mathematics of investments, and an introduction to the more common investment vehicles.

COURSE OBJECTIVES: To introduce the student to the fundamentals of investing and some of the tools needed to design and implement an investment program. To facilitate the learning, a portion of each class will be devoted to current investment news. To give the course a practical side, an investment game will be played.
