Admission to the beekeeping program.

CALENDAR DESCRIPTION:

This course addresses the practical skills needed for day-to-day commercial beekeeping operations. These include safety, truck & forklift driving and maintenance, loading and tying a truck, preparing brood chambers and assembling supers.

CREDIT/CONTACT HOURS:

This course consists of 3 lab hours a week for 9 weeks; a total of 27 hours.

DELIVERY MODES:

The course work includes demonstrations and hands-on lab activities, class participation, and assignments as set by instructor.

OBJECTIVES:

1. Introduce students, by hands-on experience, to the basic, every day skills required at a commercial apiary.
2. Ensure basic safety as related to machines and work at a commercial apiary.
