BK110 – Technical Woodworking Course Package

#### **CALENDAR DESCRIPTION:**

This hands-on course is designed to give students basic skills with saws and woodworking equipment used to manufacture beehives and related equipment.

#### **CREDIT/CONTACT HOURS:**

This course consists of 1 lecture hour and 4 lab hours a week for 9 weeks; total of 45 hours.

#### **DELIVERY MODES:**

Course work includes lectures, shop work, discussions, assigned readings, a hive project, and 3 topic/tool tests.

#### **OBJECTIVES:**

1. Students will become familiar with hand tools (portable and bench) used by beekeepers in the construction of hives.
2. Each student will build at least 2 hive-related projects

3. This course assumes *no* familiarity with woodworking practices. For experienced students projects of a more advanced nature may be developed
