Course Content:

This course is intended to serve as the first computing course for students in the Bachelor of Commerce program. The student will become familiar with general computing concepts and terminology as well as gaining an understanding and appreciation of the impact that computer technology is having on society. The lab portion of the course will provide students with hands on experience on several popular microcomputer software packages: WordPerfect 5.1, Paradox 3.5, Quattro Pro 3. Furthermore everyone is expected to gain a working knowledge of the DOS operating system for IBM PC Compatibles. If time permits a brief introduction to programming in a high level language will be provided.

Each student is expected to complete a variety of assignments on each of the software packages introduced.
