Apply skills and techniques for effective communication.

The degree of knowledge and understanding of the elements and principles of this particular studio discipline. 3. Professional orientation as indicated by enthusiasm, commitment, involvement and flexibility in collective and individual critiques. 4. Overdue assignments will be penalized 10% per day. Work must be completed within Five days of original deadline. After 5 days you will receive a zero grade. 5.
