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2. **Prerequisite**
DD 2180 or consent of the department.
3. **Catalogue Description**
A continuation of DD 2180 and the exploration of emerging technologies as applied to the visual arts. Students will use microcomputers as an tool in the production of art in a studio environment. This is a user oriented course and as such will focus on using and responding to the technology for visual communication.
4. **Course Objectives**
Students will:
 - a. Utilise computer skills developed in DD 2180 appropriate to the visual arts
 - b. Expand their own personal vocabulary for expression and communication.
 - c. Produce a professional project which demonstrates the diversity and depth of their knowledge and skills.
5. **Course Content**
Classes will be in the form of seminars and workshops concentrating on specific topics
6. **Assignments**
Assignments will be designed to foster understanding in both the theoretical and practical aspects of the technology for visual communication. A portfolio of work that cumulates in one major project will be required.
7. **Evaluation**
 - a. Weekly progress reports and individual projects 40%
 - b. Final portfolio with project summary and development work 50%
 - c. Participation 10%
