Technology and the Visual Arts 3 (1-0-5) UT (3)

- 1. Prerequisite**
DD2190, DD2270 or consent of the department.
- 2. Catalogue Description**
Students will use microcomputers as a tool in the production of art in a studio environment and will focus on using and responding to the technology for visual communication.
- 3. Course Objectives**
Students will expand their own personal vocabulary for expression and communication while focusing on a major work or significant portfolio of related work.
Students will also become cognizant of and analyze the philosophical and aesthetic implications of the new technology.
- 4. Project Content**
Projects will be developed in consultation with the instructor and will be designed to foster an understanding in both the theoretical and practical aspects of new media for visual communication. An oral and written presentation may be required to accompany the final portfolio.
- 5. Evaluations**
Evaluation will be based on a written contract between the student and instructor as outlined in the initial presentation. It will include evaluation of term work and final presentation.
