Assignments: Regular reading assignments of the following plays along with in-class presentations: OEDIPUS REX, SCHOOL FOR SCANDAL, THE GLASS MENAGERIE HEDDA GABLER, and FOOTFALLS. Attendance at a performance of She Stoops to Conquer and group discussions complete the workload.
