COURSE DESCRIPTION:	This course introduces the student to simple French, providing basic conversation skills, grammatical structures and vocabulary.
LEVEL OF COURSE:	French 0110 is a beginners French course carrying 3 college credits - but not university credits. It may be considered the equivalent of French 10 on the three-year high-school French program. Students completing French 0110 are prepared to enter French 0120. Students who have not taken French 30 in high school may then receive 6 university transfer credits by completing French 0120/0130.
TEXT:	<u>Rendez-vous An Invitation to French</u> (Third Edition) is the text. this text will be used in French 0120 and 0130 as well. The "cahier" or notebook will also be used. You will require a good quality cassette tape.
ATTENDANCE AND ASSIGNMENTS:	As new language structures are going to be introduced continually, class attendance is deemed essential. A pattern of missing classes will eventually manifest itself in a student's performance and in his grade. Assignments are expected to be done on time. A 5% penalty per day will be applied after due dates.
EXAMINATIONS:	Besides bi-weekly tests, two major examinations will be given which test both written and oral skills: a <u>mid-term</u> and a <u>final examination</u> .
