COURSE TITLE: Basic Skills for Reading French (3 UT credits)

PREREQUISITE: French 30 or equivalent

COURSE DESCRIPTION:

When offered as a separate course, French 1550 consists of a review of French grammar and the acquisition of vocabulary designed to develop skills in reading French; as such, class discussions are in English.

However, in 1997, this course is offered in tandem with FR1500. Students will complete the requirements for FR1550 by taking the first half of FR1500. See the course outline for FR1500.

FR1550 may not be counted toward a French major. It may not be taken by students who have completed FR1500 or higher level.
