Course Description: Private instruction in piano.

Prerequisite: Consent of the department or audition

The Course in Perspective: The goal of applied piano instruction is to expand the musical capabilities of each student, so that they can become a technically proficient and competent musician. Course content will include the study and performance of various musical styles, sight-reading, ear training and technique. A master class will be held weekly to give the students an opportunity to perform and discuss topics pertaining to piano performance. Students are strongly urged to participate in student concerts and master classes. A brief jury, which includes technique and repertoire pieces of two contrasting styles, is held for the faculty of the department at the end of each semester following the last day of classes.
