I. Course Description

Private instruction in voice or an instrument other than the major applied study.

II. Prerequisite

Restricted to students in B. Mus programs, and B. Ed. students majoring in secondary music education. Permission from the department is necessary. Students may be asked to play an audition prior to being admitted to the course.

III. Corequisite

Students may be asked by the instructor to perform on the instrument studied in a college ensemble.

IV. The Course in Perspective

This course is one of private applied instruction for music majors on an instrument (or voice) other than their major instrument. It is a single-term course offered over the full year.

V. Assignments

Studies and pieces will be assigned by the instructor. Students will be expected to have practiced the assigned material. If a student is unprepared for the lesson, the instructor may dismiss the student from the lesson.

VI. Grading

Students will be required to take a jury at the end of the first term, and then at the end of the year. A grade will be assigned by the applied instructor in consultation with the jury.
