Course Description: Private instruction in piano.

Prerequisite: MU 1250 or MU 1240

The Course in Perspective: The senior level course in applied piano aims to further develop the technical and musical skills of the student. Course content will include the study and performance of various musical styles, sight-reading, ear training and technique. A master class will be held weekly to give the students an opportunity to perform and discuss topics pertaining to piano performance. Students are strongly urged to participate in student concerts and master classes. A brief jury for the faculty of the department is required at the end of each semester following the last day of classes. Requirements for each jury include a display of technique and a minimum of two repertoire pieces in contrasting styles.

Grading: 60% performance and preparation for weekly lessons

(30% per semester) 30% jury performance (15% per semester)

10 % attendance at the MAD Friday Presentations 1:00-2:00 p.m. L106

(5% per semester)
