# COURSE OUTLINE – MU2250O GUITAR

#### PREREQUISITE(S)/COREQUISITE: MU1250

You must be simultaneously enrolled in MU2400 or MU2410 as a lab component.

**REQUIRED TEXT/RESOURCE MATERIALS:** You will be required to purchase appropriate repertoire and instrument supplies.

**CALENDAR DESCRIPTION:** Private study of voice or your principal instrument. This is a two-term course offered over fall/winter terms. It is identifiable in the Schedule of Courses (Timetable) with a Part A and a Part B. Students must register in both the Part A and the Part B of all types of sections offered (sections, labs, seminars, etc.) for this course.
