Course Description	This course focuses on the development of keyboarding speed and accuracy through proven individualized skill building drills
Course Objectives	The student will master touch keyboarding including alphabetic, non-alphabetic and numeric parts of the keyboard. Students should be able to touch-type at a minimum speed of 30 net words per minute on a straight copy 5 minute timed writing.
Grading	Keyboarding 90% Term Assignments 10%

A minimum of 30 nwpm (net words per minute) is required to pass this course and progress to the next level and this will be determined by 5 minute timed writings.

Net words will be calculated using the following format gross words per minute (gwpm) minus 2 words for each error equals net words per minute (nwpm)

$$\text{nwpm} = \text{gwpm} - 2 \text{ words for each error}$$
