THE COURSE is designed to accompany English 120, and is especially intended for those who feel their basic English writing skills need improvement. All students in the course will receive as much individual help as class size allows.

OBJECTIVES:

A student completing WL 120 should be able to:

- write grammatically correct sentences
- construct clear, coherent compositions
- proofread to eliminate errors in spelling, punctuation or grammar

TEXT: ENGLISH SIMPLIFIED (Ellsworth)
In addition, A CANADIAN WRITER'S HANDBOOK (Hacker) is recommended.

UNITS:

1. BUILDING BLOCKS (basic grammar/mechanics review)
2. THE WRITING PROCESS (tackling the essay)
3. DETAILS (individual writing problems)

GRADES:

100% of your final standing in this class will be based on the progress you make on a day-to-day basis, and the effort you put into improving your writing skills. This standing will be recorded on your transcript on a simple CREDIT (CR)/NO CREDIT (NC) basis, with no numerical value or grade being assigned. Writing Lab results therefore will not be factored into your Grade Point Average, But Writing Lab, along with Reading Lab can be counted as a course credited toward a GENERAL Grade XII diploma.
